Additional Supplementary Regulation No 1: Covid-19 Prevention Protocols –

Summary – to be read in conjunction with detailed provisions

Version 2, 11/6/2021

A. COVID TESTING AS A CONDITION FOR ENTRANCE TO THE EVENT

1. Proof of a negative PCR test from a Government recognised laboratory is required within 96 hours of your arrival at the event.
2. Response-Med will offer a discounted PCR test at a cost of 2500/= per person
3. You will be exempted from a PCR test if you have had a covid vaccine including the 2nd dose applied by the end of June 2021. Proof of vaccination is required.
4. Children under 12 are exempt from a PCR test. Proof of age is required.

B. TEMPERATURE CHECKS AT THE EVENT

1. There will be mandatory body temperature checks
 - a) *At Venue Checkin, Headquarters & Scrutineering*
 - b) *At selected other event locations.*
2. Participants whose temperature is above 37.3 degrees will be required to undergo a medical assessment by Response-Med.
3. Team Leaders will be required to check temperatures of all people within camp daily and keep a record of those temperature checks.

C. CAMP BUBBLES AND SOCIAL DISTANCING

1. The maximum limit for individual camps bubbles is 100 people. However everyone is strongly encouraged to reduce your bubble size as low as possible below this limit.
2. Teams may join together in one camp bubble.
3. Each camp bubble must remain separate from other bubbles at all times. This includes the following restrictions.
 - a) *No sharing of vehicles between different bubbles*
 - b) *No socialising is permitted between different bubbles*
4. When people are outside of their camp bubble area
 - a) *Masks are mandatory when in close contact with others.*
 - b) *Social distancing is mandatory*



D. COVID CASES/SUSPECTED COVID CASE HANDLING CHAIN

1. **Stay in place** and report the suspected case to an official immediately (names below):
 - a) *Diana Carson – Response Med – 0720522562*
 - b) *Amar Desai – Rhino Charge Committee – 0721 762080*
 - c) *Don White – Rhino Charge Committee- 0724319785*
2. **Wait** for Response Med to instruct you as to how to respond next.
3. **Do NOT**
 - a) *Move the suspected patient.*
 - b) *Expose yourself to risk.*
 - c) *Expose others to risk.*

E. COVID DECISION MAKING AT RHINO CHARGE 2021

1. Response-Med are the appointed Medical Providers at Rhino Charge 2021.
2. Medical decision making, including on suspected cases of Covid-19, will be by Response-Med and will be supported by the Rhino Charge organisers. This may include the decision to exclude or remove participants from the venue.
3. Response-Med's decisions are final and non-negotiable.

F. CONSEQUENCES FOR FAILURE TO ADHERE TO COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

The Rhino Charge Committee, in performance of its duty of care to all participants and the local community, may enforce the following sanctions to individuals or groups who fail to comply with these guidelines or behave irresponsibly, putting themselves or others at risk:

1. **A Penalty or Fine(s) for the individual or groups.**
2. **Immediate removal from the Rhino Charge Venue for the individual or the group**
3. **Prevention of Further Participation in the Rhino Charge event.**

In the event that the Rhino Charge Committee enforces these actions or where an individual is excluded because of a medical decision, there will be no refund of entry fees, Land Access Fees (LAF) and no recompense for any foregone expenses (e.g., costs paid to camp operators, cancellation fees) or any responsibility for consequential loss whatsoever by The Rhino Charge Committee, Rhino Ark or Response-Med and their officials and employees.

A signed individual indemnity agreeing to these conditions is required as a condition of entry to the venue, by everybody attending Rhino Charge 2021.
