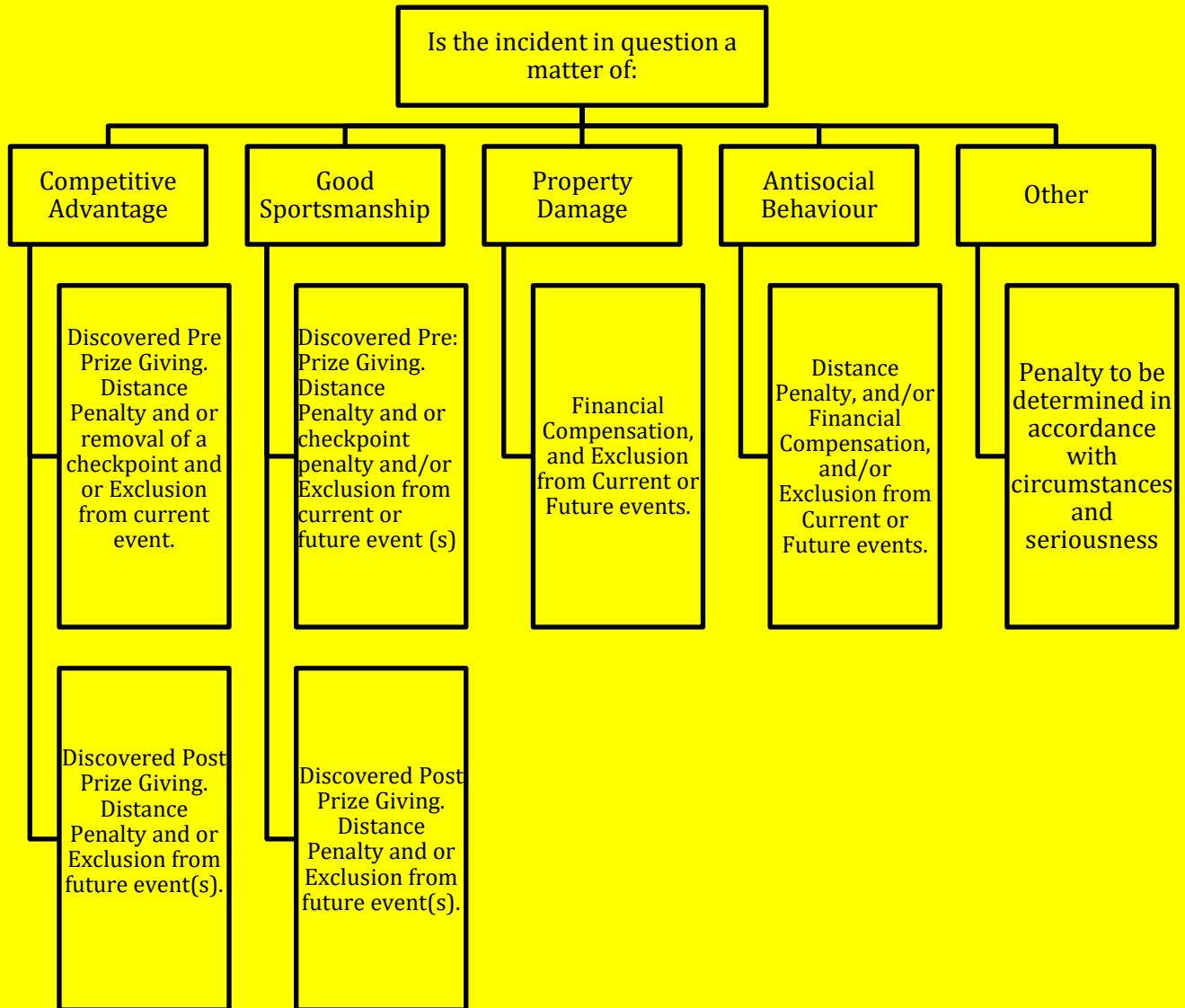
N17 . Non-GPS-Data Protests, Affecting Results.

- a. A competitor may submit a protest [excluding GPS/Tracking matters as defined in Bulletin 2] **in writing** to the Clerk of the Course (**exclusively via email to management@rhinocharge.or.ke**) by **7am on the day of the official Prize-Giving Ceremony**. Submissions received after this deadline will not be considered.
- b. A fee of 30,000/= per submission will be required, which is refundable in the event of a successful protest.
- c. Written submissions must include:
 - The competitor's team name and car number.
 - A clear and specific description of the alleged incident and rules broken
 - Any supporting evidence
- d. Competitors doing so must be present at HQ tent in person between 8am and 10am for questioning by Event Stewards.
- e. Event Stewards will review information and may issue rulings prior to prize-giving.

N18 . Penalty Appeal Post Prize-Giving.

Participants may appeal any penalties [excluding GPS/Tracking matters as defined in Bulletin 2] issued after prize giving, subject to a fee of 300,000/= which may be refunded in the event of a successful outcome.
